Student, daughter, Girl Scout, singer, leader. . . . You have so many roles! You can have fun making paper dolls and decorating them to represent all your roles.

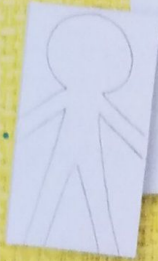
MATERIALS

- Paper
- Crayons or colored markers or pencils
- Bits of fabric, sequins, and other odds and ends to decorate
- Scissors

Start with a sheet of white paper and fold it over and over, like a fan.

Then draw a doll on the top of the folded paper. Be sure the doll's arms reach all the way to the sides of the paper.

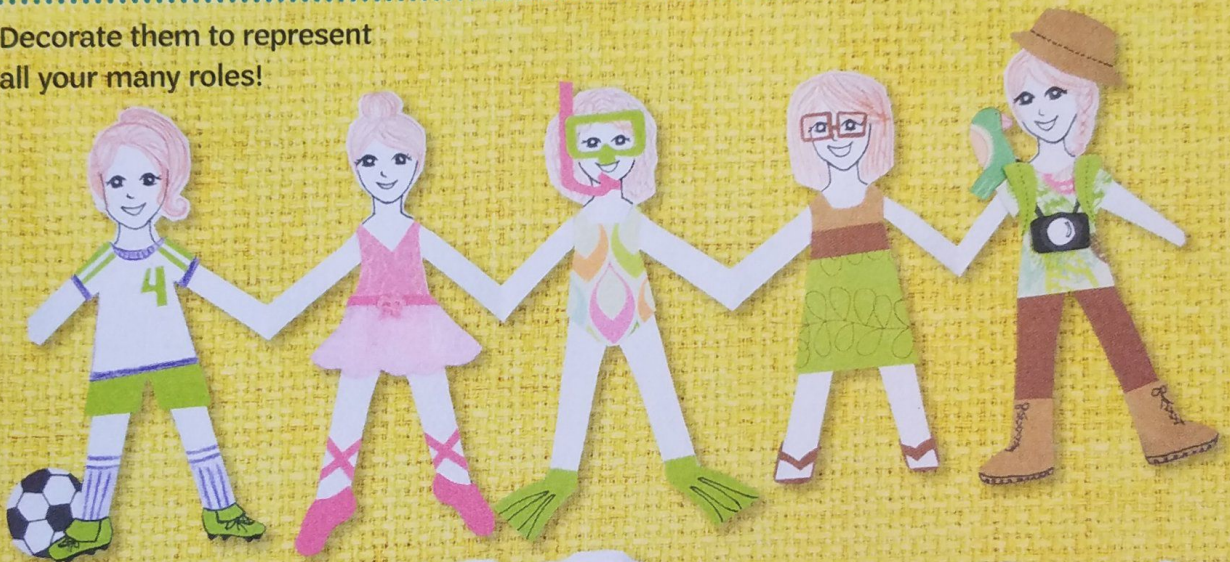

Next, cut out your doll but not the sides! Open up the string of dolls. They'll look like they're holding hands.

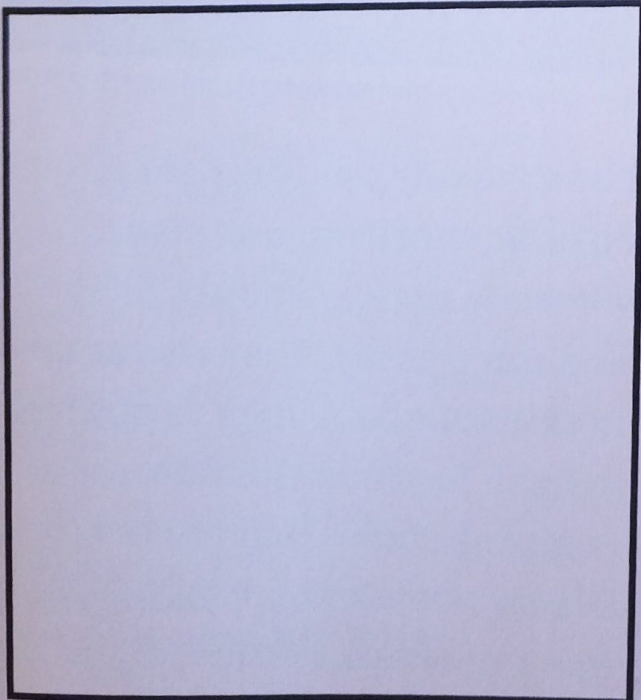
